


Memorandum of Agreement  
Between  
Regional Transit Service Inc. ("Company")  
And  
Amalgamated Transit Union, 282 ("Union")


The parties met in ad hoc to discuss calling overtime. The parties agreed to the following:

When Operators are called in for a.m. overtime on their day off, they need to notify the Dispatcher at the time they accept the overtime if they are not available all day, in which case they will still be available until 2pm. If a full run being given to an Operator only available until 2pm goes beyond 2pm then they will get at least the first piece of work or the start of the run. The remainder of the run will be handed out according to extra board rules. Operators with limited availability may be kept at Dispatcher discretion until 2pm. If a run is a "straight eight" you must be able to complete at least four hours up to 2pm.

The parties agreed this Agreement will go into effect on November 1, 2021.
