Fire Door Replacement Project

The parties agree as follows:


1. ATU 282 B&G mechanical employees to do all removal of existing fire doors and hardware as required by project, including patch and fill in of holes in existing walls and structures as required by project plans.
2. ATU 282 B&G mechanical employees to do all removal of preexisting exit signs and decommissioning of assorted electrical connections, conduit and boxes.
3. All warranty work, or certification of warranty work, will be performed by the manufacturer/contractor or their factory chosen representative. A B&G mechanical employee will be assigned to assist when such work is performed.


ATU 282 agrees that all annual certification/testing will be performed by a certified contractor. An ATU 282 B&G mechanical employee will assist the certified contractor.


4. Fire door repairs, after warranties have expired, will be performed by ATU B&G mechanical employees. Any certification/testing that is required after a repair will be performed by a certified contractor. An ATU 282 B&G mechanical employee will assist the certified contractor.


ATU agrees that the installation of the fire doors will be performed by the contractor. An ATU 282 B&G mechanical employee will assist the contractor.
